BYLAW NO 175-08

A BYLAW TO APPOINT A BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

The Council of the Town of Kelvington in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a) "Council" means the Council of the Town of Kelvington; and
 - b) "Municipality" means the Town of Kelvington.
2. Council hereby appoints Flaman Investigation and Security Agency Ltd. as the Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the Municipality.
 - o The appointment shall commence April 1, 2008.
3. The appointment may be terminated by Council or by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer giving one month's written notice.
4. The duties of a Bylaw Enforcement Officer shall be:
 - a) to enforce all municipal bylaws enacted by the council of the Municipality
 - b) to represent the Municipality before a justice of the peace or provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with contravention of a bylaw;
 - c) and other duties as may be assigned by council or its delegate.
5. The Bylaw Enforcement Officer shall be remunerated in the following manner:

a) Bylaw Enforcement- 1 Enforcement Officer x 2 hours	\$230.00
Extra time (per hour)	19.00
b) Mileage-\$0.65 per km (approx. 45km per visit)	29.25
c) Summons Preparation	75.00
d) Service of Summons	65.00
e) Court Appearance	150.00
6. Bylaw #168-05 is hereby repealed.
7. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on April 1, 2008.
