BYLAW NO.165-05

**A BYLAW TO REGULATE AND GOVERN THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS AND
EXPLOSIVES IN THE TOWN OF KELVINGTON**

The Council of the Town of Kelvington in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Bylaw No. 79, a bylaw to regulate and govern the discharge of firearms and explosives in the town and Bylaw No. 156-02, a bylaw to appoint a bylaw enforcement officer, are hereby repealed.
2. No person or persons shall fire or discharge any air or pellet gun, use any class of guns, firearms or other devices that are designed for or capable of discharging projectiles of any type within the limits of the Town of Kelvington except as provided elsewhere in this bylaw.
3. For the purpose of pest control only, the Town Council hereby appoints Gerald Whitehead to discharge a firearm within the Town limits.
4. The Royal Canadian Mounted Police shall verify that he is qualified before the appointment is effective. This appointment shall continue until terminated on written notice by the Council of the Town of Kelvington or by Gerald Whitehead.
