BYLAW NO. 170-05

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF KELVINGTON TO PROVIDE FOR THE MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL OF THE KELVINGTON RECREATIONAL ARENA.

THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KELVINGTON HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The skating rink situated on Parcel M Plan AO6295 in the Town of Kelvington in the Province of Saskatchewan, shall be controlled, supervised, and managed by a Board to be known as the Rink Board.
2. Generally, the Rink Board shall consist of nine members.
3. The members shall be appointed by the Council annually. An appointed member may resign by giving written notice to the Council. In the event of death or resignation of any member of the Board, the Council shall appoint a member to fill the vacancy for the unexpired term.
4. Each year in the fall, prior to the opening of the rink, the Board shall hold an annual meeting open to the public.
5. At the annual meeting, the members may appoint an executive committee. The executive committee shall consist of: the past president, the president, and the vice-president. The executive committee shall serve for two (2) years.
6. The Board shall hold regular meetings to conduct business. The minutes of each regular Rink Board meeting shall be presented to Council.
7. The Board shall be committed to promoting year around utilization of the Kelvington Recreational Arena by area residents and visitors; oversee the orderly, efficient and cost effective operation of the facility so as to generate a positive economic impact for the Kelvington area; preserve, maintain and improve the physical assets of the arena and/or innovative solutions to current and long range challenges; and provide services within the arena to meet the community's current and changing needs, situations and population.
8. Through cooperation and coordination, the Board is also responsible for sound recreation programming. The objective is to promote participation in programs associated with the Kelvington Recreation Arena by area residents and visitors. The Board shall oversee the orderly operations of the arena so as to generate good will and a positive image for the Town of Kelvington. The Board shall oversee, preserve and improve the physical assets of minor sports by encouraging sound, progressive management practices.
9. The Board will have control and supervision over the employment, promotion, and discharge of personnel as deemed necessary by the committee.
10. The Board shall have full authority to limit the conduct of any person within the arena such as may be necessary to protect the arena and the safety of persons there at or the employment of the users there in.
11. This bylaw shall come into effect January 1, 2006.
